Dear Mr Oman,

Thank you for your letter dated 18 December 2015 in which you express your concerns about the possible impacts on wild animals of razor wire fences installed along the Croatian border with Hungary and Slovenia. Commissioner Vella has asked me to reply on his behalf.

In relation to the fence placed along the Croatian-Hungarian border, so far the Commission did not identify any breach of the EU environmental legislation, including the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC). It should be noted that according to the information available to the Commission services, the affected species are not strictly protected under the Directive and there is no obligation to designate Natura 2000 sites for those species either.

The Commission is also aware of the activities along the Slovenian-Croatian border and intends to closely monitor the situation to ensure that EU nature legislation is respected.
